- Left on East Ave to Route 517/182.
- South to 57 W to Washington, Route 31 S.
- Follow directions from Rt. 31 S.

#### Travelling I-80 Eastbound

• Exit 4B to Rt.46 East to Rt.31 South in the direction of Trenton/Washington. In Washington follow the signs to the Blue Army Shrine.

#### I-78 East OR West

- Take I-78 to Exit 17 (Route 31 N) to Washington.
- Follow directions from Rt. 31 N.

- Follow Local Area Directions Below






